Description: The Central Texas Community Enrichment Project will examine poverty and how it affects community life. The project will allow participants to volunteer with four areas of poverty. The project serves community need by:

- Environmental beautification and public art projects at the Guerrero-Colorado River Park (125 volunteers)
- Implanting signs and clearing trail for safety along Shoal Creek Greenbelt (125 volunteers)
- Sorting food and participating in a community clean-up march with the Hays Food Bank (125 volunteers)
- Removing hazardous debris and improving watersheds along Copperfield Nature Trails (125 volunteers)

Possible tasks include: removing invasive plants, litter collection, placing tile/mosaic pieces on community benches/park structures, mulching, planting trees, installing signage, food drive, and trail improvements.
